

Not Your Mother's Easter Sermon

Easter Sunday is a special day for many people around the world. It is a jam packed day full of faith, family and friends. A morning celebration of our Lord and Savior, followed by fellowship, good food and the inauguration of the Spring season. Growing up, Easter was always eventful; an Easter Church Service preceded an Easter Egg Hunt, that preceded an Easter Brunch, which preceded an Easter Nap, which preceded an Easter Dessert and concluded with a "Good Easter's Night's Sleep." But something wasn't right. At the time I didn't understand, as I was just a child. I was too blinded by the facade of food, easter eggs, and candy to actually ponder the question, "Do I believe in the Resurrection of Jesus Christ?"

At the time did I believe in God? **Yes, I did.** Did I believe in Jesus? **Yup, I did.** Did I believe that Jesus was a really good guy who did a lot of really good things? **Of course.** But did I fully know and believe in my heart that God sent His only begotten son, Jesus Christ, down to Earth to redeem humanity? Did I believe that after He was crucified, died, and buried, He was resurrected in accordance with the Holy Scriptures for the forgiveness of our sins? In other words, did I fully believe who Jesus was who He said He was? Well, I guess my true answer to you would have been "**I don't know.**"

I know that today is a special day for many of you, and you probably want me to preach something nostalgic that reminds you of your childhood. 
