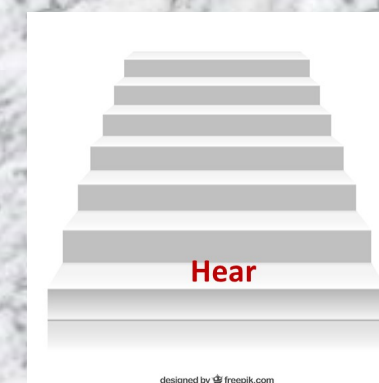

Steps to Salvation #1

Over the next several weeks we are going to look at the "steps to salvation" that God has given to the world through the blood and death of His Son. You might have heard about this list before being talked about within the Church and that there are 5 steps. However, if we look in the Scripture, we will see that there were actually 7 given! We will go over the whole list of them and then highlight a different step each week.

1. **Hear** - That God created all things (**Genesis 1:1**), including you, and has the only right to direct how existence is to be. God gave roughly four dozen men across some 1,600 years, multiple countries, and multiple languages a single book for all humans to read, called the Bible, to guide humanity's existence (**2 Timothy 3:16**). The Bible describes that all humans have a physical mortal body containing an immortal soul. All humans who develop to the point of understanding right from wrong have sinned by choosing to do wrong, missing the mark of how God designed them to live (**Romans 3:23**). Sin is punished each time by death (**Romans 6:23**). God does not condemn a sinner's body to physical death upon sinning, but instead condemns their immortal souls to suffer spiritual death by being cast into Hell (a lake of fire) forever (**Revelation 20:14-15**). You are in this category and cannot save yourself from this punishment. You cannot escape unless God Himself saves you from this fate. However, God in His infinite love sent His Son Jesus to earth to die as a sacrificial replacement for any sinner who would accept Him dying in their place. And God has offered a way of escape! 3. **Count the cost**
4. **Repent**
5. **Confess**
6. **Be baptized**
7. **Live for Christ**
